Reminders

Library Books: It is important for your child to bring their library book into school. As you know they change them on a Thursday.

Parent Helpers: Your help in class is always appreciated. Please come and speak to a member of staff if you can spare an hour or two to help with classroom activities or to listen to children read. You do need to have a DBS check before you can do this. Please speak to the school office.

P.E. Kit: Please make sure your child is wearing suitable PE clothes to school on a Monday and Friday. They need to wear warm, outdoor clothes (jogging bottoms or leggings) and suitable trainers/plimsolls. On a similar note, children need a warm, waterproof coat in school everyday as the weather can quickly change at playtimes.
